Visit to Delphi – the "navel" of ancient Greece

According to legend, Zeus released two eagles from the ends of the earth and it was at Delphi that the two majestic birds met. It was this legend that made Delphi the centre of the ancient Greek world. Discover the Temple of Apollo and visit the archaeological museum, not forgetting the magnificent view of the surrounding mountains.





Visit to Volos

Discover the Old Town, the Museum, the Church of Agios Nikolaos and the Argo - the legendary replica of Jason and the Argonauts' crossing. Volos is a friendly town that invites you to stroll through the pedestrian area along the sea and enjoy a meze accompanied by a tsipouro or a glass of ouzo in one of the famous "Tsipouradikos".








Visit to Mount Pelion

Visit to Makrinitsa






The little train and its panoramic route

Please note: the "Moutzouri" does not run every day or all year round.






Visit to Meteora

Some monasteries are open to the public... follow the history of the Orthodox monks by discovering the secrets of these sacred places. Enjoy the magnificent views and nature of this mythical region.

Special tip:

To fully experience the magic of the Meteora, an overnight stay in the surrounding area is recommended.





Visit to Metsovo

Metsovo – a jewel on a lush green mountain side with spectacular natural beauty. A mountain town where are, culture and traditions are respected. Appreciate this great and inviting village atmosphere by walking along the narrow streets between the stone houses, visit the folk-art museum in the Tossizza manor house, discover the Agia Paraskevi Orthodox church in the main square. The region is also renowned for its local produce, such as metsovone, an artisan cheese.





Visit to Ioannina

Ioannina, a town on the shores of Lake Pamvotida, a beautiful old town protected by a fortress that testifies of its history, narrow streets, old, renovated houses... a picturesque town with strong cultural traditions that is worth a visit.

In the middle of the lake – the area's trademark - lies the small island of Ioannina, which is linked by regular boats and can be visited.





Visit to the Zagorochoria region and the Vikos Gorge

Zagorochoria is a group of 46 picturesque villages in the Pindus Mountain range. An environment of steep cliffs, dense forests, small lakes, rivers and arched limestone bridges. A magnificent region for walking, hiking or mountain biking... The Voidomatis River is a paradise for refting and kayak fans. Don't miss the Vikos Gorge, a natural monument with rare plants and it is classified by the Guiness Book as the deepest gorge in relation to its width.







Nature and adrenaline on the Acheron River

Perfect for nature lovers looking for action and adrenaline. Whether it's trekking, horseriding, rafting or paragliding, there's something for everyone. Even a walk along the river or simply enjoying nature is worthwhile.





Visit to Parga

Parga, a colourful maritime place on the Ionian coast. From the Venetian castle that dominates the town, you can enjoy the magnificent vie over the bay and the small island Panagia. The narrow streets invite you to take a stroll through the old town. Take advantage of the location to sit on the terrace for a coffee or a good meal.





Visit to Thessaloniki

Discover the archaeological museum, the Old Town and the history of this city destroyed by fire in 1917. Follow in the footsteps of the Romans, Byzantines and Ottomans.

Thessaloniki is a lively city with a reputation for good food and a great nightlife. Stroll along the seafront promenade and relax with a cup of coffee on the terrace.



Approximate distances:

Delphi – Volos : 150 km

Volos – Mount Pelion : 35 km

Volos – The Meteora : 240 km

Metsovo – Ioannina : 50 km Ioannina – Zagorochoria : 60 km Ioannina – Acheron : 75 km Acheron – Parga : 30 km Parga – Ioannina : 100 km Ioannina – Thessaloniki : 260 km
